<b><u>Volunteering at the school/in the classroom</u></b>		
<b>TA/tutoring/classroom helper</b> – especially 9:15-10:15 Elementary School reading and 10:30-11:30 Elementary & High School math. <b>Grades:                      Days:                      Times:</b>		
<b>Playground supervision</b> – especially 8:15-8:30, perhaps volunteer to do that one day a week for the year		
<b>Teach a module</b> on your hobby/trade/profession – this would entail 1 hr/day, 4 days a week for 2 months, in the afternoon. Also possibility in some subjects of working with a teacher for a shorter module. Ideas - carpentry, welding, graphic design, first aid, art/painting/pottery, web design, bookkeeping, basic life skills, etc.)		
<b>Take on a student apprentice</b> at your job as part of co-op program – 8 weeks, 5 days a week for the whole afternoon.		
<b>Coach a sport</b> – particularly cross country and flag football in the spring suggested so far		
<b><u>Helping with class trips</u></b> – transportation, etc.		
<b><u>Library</u></b>		
Set up and oversee Elementary School library		
Help with and build selection in High School library		

<b><u>Events</u></b>		
Lead/organize/run a special event (current need for someone to do this for our Harvest Festival Family Fun Day)		
Be on the list of helpers for events (baking, set & clean up, etc, etc)		
<b><u>Board</u></b>		
Serve on the board		
Join a board level committee – finance, promotion, fund raising, rentals, facility, nominations & membership		
<b><u>Admin</u></b>		
Help in office 2 hrs/week – run errands, misc. jobs		
Marking papers for teachers		
<b><u>Communications</u></b>		
Develop alumni communications and engagement		
Newsletters, Beacon		
<b><u>Technology</u></b>		
School computer and technical needs		
School website, online presence		
<b><u>Art/Graphic Design</u></b>		
Help with brochure development, etc.		
School décor (Bible verses, art, school history wall, etc.)		
Offer module or class in specific art form – pottery, painting, etc.		
<b><u>Handy man/carpentry/maintenance skills</u></b>		
Help with a multitude of small projects/jobs around the school		
Teach carpentry or other maintenance skills		
Coop – apprentice a student for 8 week module in your field		

<b><u>Health</u></b>		
First aid supplies monthly inventory and needs list – approx. 1-1½ hrs. each month.		
Offer a First Aid course		
<b><u>Photography</u></b>		
Take pictures at school events and around the school for promotional purposes		
Offer photography lessons/module		
<b><u>Landscaping</u></b>		
Lawnmowing in season		
Enhance the playground		
Flowers, etc, around the school grounds (plant and ongoing care)

Liaison with different language groups		
Language practice, cultural events, etc.
